INFORMATION ON GRANTS

The Gower Society Youth Action section of the Gower Society is prepared to make grants of up to £500 towards projects that encourage young people residing in, or visiting, the Lordship of Gower to understand, appreciate and enhance their natural environment.

The young people should be involved with the preparation of the grant application and evidence of their contribution towards the application process is essential.

Applicants should complete all sections of the application form before returning it to the Gower Society Youth Action Secretary. They are also welcome to attach additional information.

Please note that grants are not normally available for the support of running costs, routine maintenance or retrospectively.

If an application is approved, the Society will inform the successful applicant and the following conditions may be applied:

1. If approval is given by the Society and grant confirmation made, then the applicant must normally begin the project or incur the expenditure within one year. If money is paid in advance, the Society will require that the grant be expended wholly and solely for the purpose(s) for which the grant was approved. If the project has not been carried out within the year, the society may require repayment of the grant.
2. Where a grant is given for a project which will require continuing maintenance, it is expected that details of this will be included in the application.
3. The applicant is requested to supply photographs and/or a report twelve months after the grant money has been paid, showing how the project has progressed over the twelve month period.

If an applicant has any queries, the Society is always happy to discuss ideas at an early stage. If the applicant has queries, the best thing to do is to make an exploratory telephone call to the Secretary, or write a letter describing the proposals, before making formal application to the Society.
